#### Notes:

- All participants must have submitted liability waivers to participate.
- All cars must be registered with Electrathon America.
- Please refer to the Track Map on the EVERON website's Schedule Page.
- Note the locations of restrooms and other areas of interest on the Track Map.
- An ambulance standby crew will be onsite for first aid or other medical needs.
- Portable restrooms will be set up near the track.
- Assisted by members of the I-29 Speedway staff and other volunteers.
- All team and spectator parking is to the south of the grandstand. Spectators, please give preference to the team vehicles for the spots closest to the track.
- Even though "Concessions" is shown on the Track Map, there is no concessions service for this rally.

- Normal vehicle inspection schedule and process. Note the Inspections area on the Track Map.
- We will have to use generators. No outlets are available.
- All competing vehicles will use transponders supplied by EVERON.
  - Transponders will be mounted on the left side for this event.
- Push vehicles to their starting positions on the track through the Pit Row exit onto the track (near Turn #10 on the Track Map).
- Starting point will be on the track at a spot near the middle of Pit Row.
- Endurance Event only using a single 60-minute heat for all vehicles plus the normal tiebreaker.
- No pit stop is required for a driver change in any Class. This is due to the rough condition of Pit Row.
- Awards for Endurance in each competition class and Best Pit Crew.
- It is possible that bad weather or other circumstances may threaten the rally. EVERON will make a “Go / No Go” decision at 3:00 PM Central Time on the day before the rally (Friday, April 24). Please check the website’s Schedule page shortly after that time and date to verify that the rally is still on.
- There is no makeup date if the rally is canceled.
- Spectators are welcome!
  - Talk with the teams, take pictures, and walk through the staging area.
  - Only approach vehicles with permission from teams.
  - View the race from designated areas in the grandstand.
